## Safe with the Shepherd - A Study of Psalm 23

Every woman longs for someone to protect and care for her -- someone to guide her when she's not sure of her next steps, to provide rest when she's worn out, to walk with her when the valley is dark. This study, authored by Jennifer Rothschild, will take participants beyond a familiar reading of this beloved Psalm to a deeper understanding of what it means for God to be our Good Shepherd. We will explore how to release our fear of whatever circumstances we are facing and trust in the Shepherd's goodness in every season of life.

## Joy of Living Bible Study - Study of Ephesians Part 2, Chapters 4-6

Last semester we learned about the spiritual "wealth" we have as believers in Jesus Christ from chapters 1-3 in the book of Ephesians. This semester, we will learn how to apply those spiritual riches to our "walk" with Jesus in chapters 4-6.
